Guidelines for AA volunteers

- Having incarceration in your story is not a requirement!
- You cannot not pass clearance if you are on, or have been on, probation and parole within the last year
- You cannot not pass clearance if you have been released from a state correctional facility within the last 5 years
- 2 years of continuous sobriety

Types of Service

1. **Guest Speaker:** Apply for clearance to enter with a VIC up to 5 times per year
2. **VIC** (Volunteer in Corrections: an unpaid employee of the State of Missouri): facilitate an AA meeting once a month (the inmates cannot have a meeting unless we are there to facilitate)
3. **Announce** at your home group, sponsees, committee or district meetings

Clearance Process

- Guest clearance can take about 3-4 weeks. Your guest application is for a particular date of entry, so some planning and cooperation with the VIC is necessary. Forms available from Sandy H
- VIC application requires a form, clearance, interview and training, which can take a few months depending on your availability throughout the process. Forms available from Sandy H
